

Maeser Prep Discipline Procedures

Students will be assigned consequences for discipline issues based on the nature of the violation. In general, students will be assigned detention or multiple periods of detention for minor or general violations of school policies. Repeated minor infractions of school policy or major infractions may receive in-school suspension, suspension, or expulsion from school depending on the nature of the problem and the student's attitude.

1. Detentions last forty-five minutes before or after school. Students are to follow directions and not talk. Students pay a \$2 fee for detention.
2. Students who fail to attend their detention(s) will either have another detention added to the previous detention(s) and/or they will be suspended from school. A parent/guardian will be notified.
3. "Suspension" is defined as a removal of ALL school-related privileges which include, but is not limited to, the loss of school-related privileges (i.e. attendance in class, lunch with friends, school activities, etc.).
4. Any discipline item not dealt with in this policy will be dealt with on an individual basis.

Explanation of "Discipline" Classifications Outlined Above:

1. "Minor Discipline" includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. Defiance of authority/disrespect
 - b. Disrupting class repeatedly
 - c. Dress Code Violation
 - d. Improper Language and/or behavior
 - e. Public display of affection
2. "General Discipline" includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. Cheating
 - b. Cyber harassment
 - c. Physical harassment
 - d. Verbal Harassment
 - e. Written harassment
3. "Major Discipline" includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. Physical assault or fighting
 - b. Pornography, sexual harassment, and/or sexual contact
 - c. Substance abuse (including legal substances used for improper/illegal purposes)
 - d. Possession of drugs and/or drug paraphernalia
 - e. Theft

Note: Law Enforcement Officers *may* be notified

4. Mandatory Expulsion will be recommended for the following (Expulsion is a very serious disciplinary action that terminates a student's attendance at Maeser Prep):
 - a. Arson
 - b. Assault on a school employee
 - c. Defacing school property or the property of others (vandalism)
 - d. Sale of an illegal substance (or sale of a legal substance for illegal purposes)
 - e. Weapons of any kind (or intended use of any kind of weapon)

Note: Law Enforcement Officers *will* be notified

Due process will be afforded each student
